

HSC Moodle 3.5.6 Minimum Hardware / Software Requirements

Internet Connection: We recommend high speed broadband or DSL Internet connection when taking a course online. Make sure your internet connection is fast and reliable to receive the best possible learning experience with Moodle. It is recommended to use hard-wired connections for submitting assignments or when taking an exam in Moodle.
